

Gil began illustrating books when he was eight years old. Unfortunately, he was usually punished for his efforts, as the sketches were done in the margins of his school books. When caught, Gil was sent home with notes to his parents enclosed in the offending book. His father, who had a keen appreciation for art himself, would read the note, gaze long and critically at the wonderful sketches and then write an apologetic letter to Gil's teacher. The incident would be forgotten...until the next time.

**The Distinguished Flying Medal**

This medal was instituted in June, 1918, and is awarded to non-commissioned officers and men of the Air Forces for "an act of valour, courage, or devotion to duty performed whilst flying in active operations against the enemy". The letters D.F.M. are used after a recipient's name and bars may be awarded for subsequent acts.

**The George Cross**

King George VI instituted this award on 23rd September, 1940, for civilians of both sexes "for acts of the greatest heroism or of the most conspicuous courage in circumstances of extreme danger." Although intended primarily for civilians, there is a Military Division to permit its award to members of the Services for actions for which purely military honours are not normally granted. Recipients use the letters G.C. after their names, and bars may be awarded for further acts of bravery.

**The Distinguished Flying Cross**

This decoration was instituted in June, 1918, for award to Officers and Warrant Officers of the Air Forces recommended for "an act of valour, courage, or devotion to duty performed whilst flying in active operations against the enemy". For further acts of bravery, bars may be awarded. Recipients use the letters D.F.C. after their names.

**Turkish Crimean Medal**

Everyone who received the *Crimean War Medal* (see No. 18) was entitled to the Turkish medal, awarded by the Sultan of Turkey. Besides British troops, those of France and Sardinia also received this medal.
