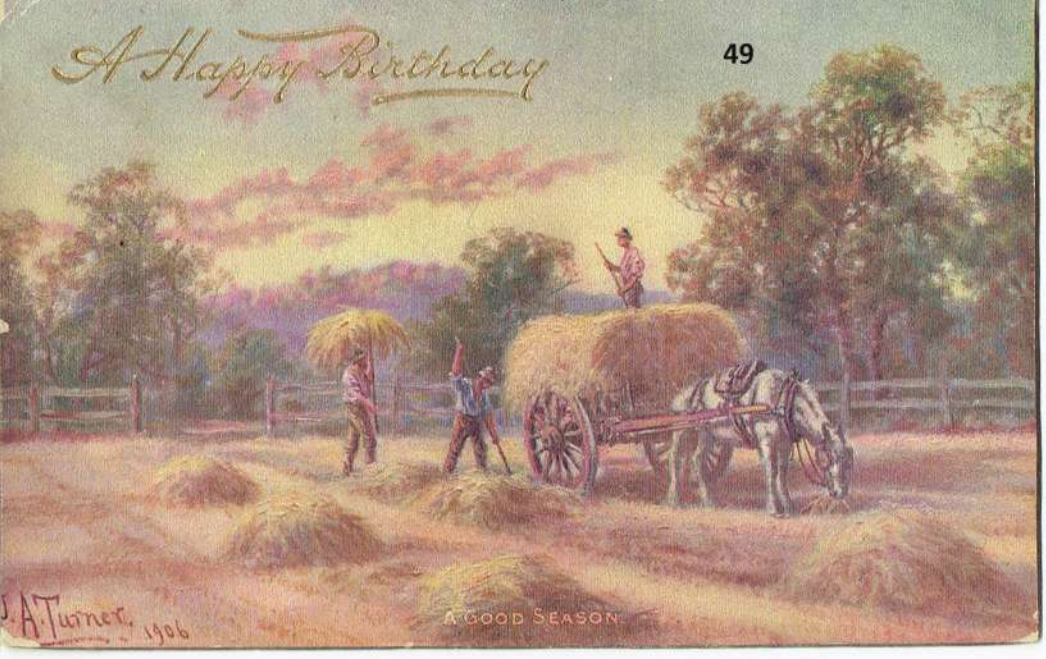
Westminster Abbey

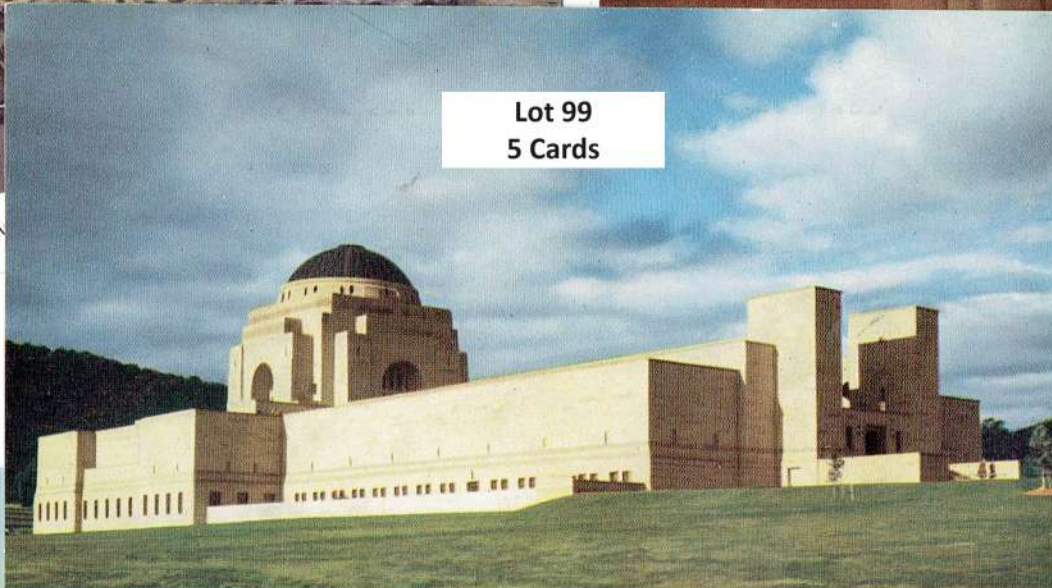

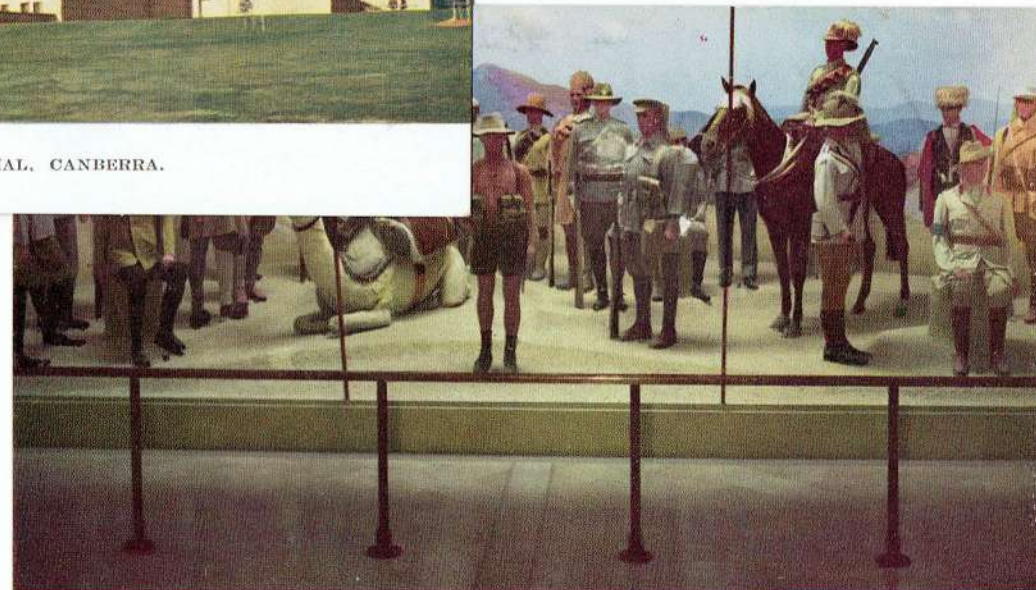
